

2024 Grape Production Report

**2024 Washington wine grape production totaled 150,000 tons,
a 5% decrease from 2023**

- Cabernet Sauvignon was the top producing variety grown in the state at 40,589 tons or 27% of the total. Riesling was ranked second, at 22,168 tons or 15% of the total. Both varieties showed a decrease from the prior year, with a decrease of 16% for Cabernet Sauvignon and 9% decrease for Riesling.
- The top seven varieties represented 86% of the overall tonnage. White varieties accounted for 45% of the total, while red varieties accounted for 55%.
- Overall red varieties experienced a decrease of 10% while white varieties experienced a 2% increase.
- Growers received an average of \$1,621 per ton for all varieties in 2024. Merlot saw the largest average price increase at \$953 based on reported sales. Malbec decreased the most, by \$79 per ton or 5%.
- Merlot received the highest average price per ton in 2024 at \$2,595. In 2023, Cabernet Franc received the highest price at \$2,254.
